Insecten Belustigung (Insect entertainment) is among the most famous and charming scientific works of the 18th century. The first volume of this large-scale project was published in 1740, when the Nuremberg miniaturist Roesel (1705-1759) set out to produce coloured engravings of

the diverse development stages of insects, thereby creating luxurious illustrations and comprehensive descriptions. Facsimile of all seven volumes totalling c. 3000 pages in the original format of 21.5 x 17.3 cm. Approx. 300 full-page colour plates with over 2000 individual depictions.
